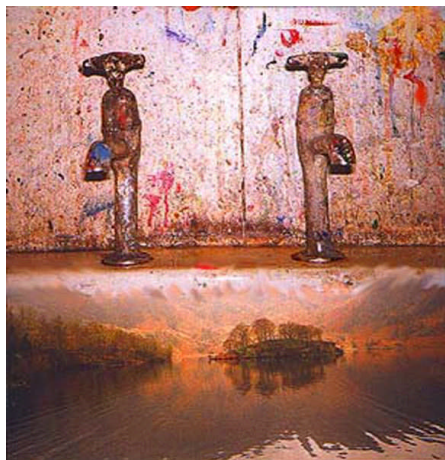


Ann Shaw – The Journey



This is the first solo exhibition of Ann Shaw originally from Wales but who now lives in Bridge of Allan. She worked as a Feature Writer on The Herald in Glasgow before taking voluntary redundancy in order to fulfill a lifelong ambition to become an artist. Graduating from Glasgow School of Art in 2001, she has exhibited in mixed exhibitions in Scotland and Wales. She will be showing, for the first time, a series of work created on her **iphone** which is possibly the first public art exhibition of work produced using this innovative technology

Also shown will be a series of hands of local people photographed during her residency "work in Progress" week in the Changing Room, Stirling.

Photographic documentary: Another first is a series of photographs taken by children over 50 years ago in a Welsh children's TB sanatorium. They formed part of three photographic exhibitions in Wales and received considerable media coverage because it was the first time any photographs had been seen of life inside a children's TB sanatorium. Ann Shaw was one of those children and last year she published a book "The Children of Craigyfyn" which she co-authored with Dr Carole Reeves of the Welcome Trust Centre for the History of Medicine, University College London.

Ann's work reflects her interest in media and technology which she uses to find the extraordinary in the ordinary.

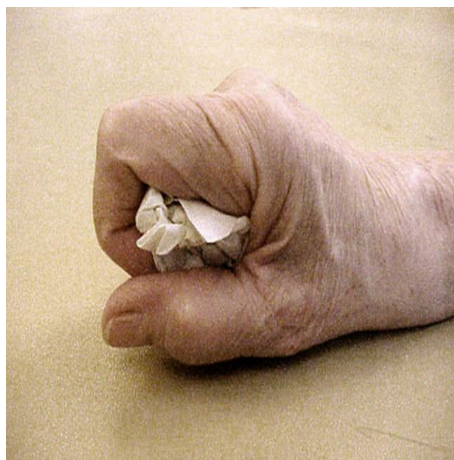
