

ART ON THE PARK



‘OIL AND WATER’ is an exhibition of paintings by Robert and Elizabeth Munn (nee Stevenson). The two west-coast artists were members of Paisley Art Institute in the 1930s. The works on show span five decades.

Robert painted mostly in watercolour and was influenced by the pure watercolour technique of Sir Russell Flint, a much admired artist of his day. Robert’s landscapes range from Cornish scenes to views of Arran, the Ayrshire coast and Tarbert in Argyll.



Elizabeth painted mostly in oils. She took classes with the celebrated flower painter Stuart Park at Glasgow School of Art and had, herself, a lifelong interest in depicting flowers, particularly roses. She also produced a series of family portraits, on view here.

There is a family link with Stirling University since the artists’ son, the late Professor Douglas Munn, was the first holder of the university’s Chair of Mathematics. Their daughter, Lesley Duncan, journalist and poet, lives in Stirling
