Symbiosis successfully raised the considerable investment that it needed in March 2011 and has subsequently moved from an office on the Innovation Park into Scion House units 6, 8, 9 and 10. Symbiosis will contract manufacture pharmaceuticals for its clients on a small scale for use in clinical trials around the world. They have subsequently embarked on the fit-out of a World Class manufacturing facility which requires the construction of several clean rooms, to be fully operational by February 2012. Their niche expertise will include the capability to manufacture both biological and conventional small molecule pharmaceuticals and the ability to work with highly potent and cytotoxic (anti-cancer) pharmaceuticals. In addition they will be able to manufacture freeze-dried pharmaceuticals. The Symbiosis team are very excited by these developments and the company is delighted to be located on the Stirling University Innovation Park.

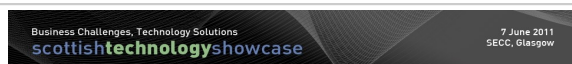

An [exhibition of paintings](#) by Robert and Elizabeth Munn (nee Stevenson). The two west-coast artists were members of Paisley Art Institute in the 1930s. The works on show span five decades.



Robert painted mostly in watercolour with his landscapes ranging from Cornish scenes to views of Arran, the Ayrshire coast and Tarbet. Elizabeth painted mostly in oils and has had a lifelong interest in depicting flowers, particularly roses. She has also produced a series of family portraits, which are also on view.

There is a family link with Stirling University since the artists' son, the late Professor Douglas Munn, was the first holder of the University's Chair of Mathematics. Their daughter, [Lesley Duncan](#), journalist and poet, lives in Stirling.
